Revelation on the White Horse

29th August 2009 Night Vigil

Halleluyah—what a mighty *Kesha* tonight and we bless the Lord for this one of a kind opportunity that the church may be able to prepare for the coming of the Lord; now we have looked at the importance of the 7 seals on the scroll. And we have looked at the fact that the first 4 seals are the most critical to the church towards the coming of the Lord in the rapture of the church. Again the reason I am able to bring all these together now; the reason I want to look at the first horsemen, again the first horse, the second horse, the third and the fourth is because it is those four that are most critical towards the coming of the Messiah in the rapture of the church.

And so we have seen very carefully that the most important prophecy the Lord ever gave to the church is the prophecy that is described in Matthew 24 and Mark chapter 13 and Luke 21. And we see that the Holy Spirit revealed to John this same prophecy that in this revelation that John received in the Book of Revelation chapter 6 we see it interpreted by the prophecy that Jesus gave in Matthew 24, Mark 13 and Luke 21. And I want us to take it forward now. I said I am going to walk with you very, very carefully tonight to look at each of the seals, the first 4 seals and why they are most critical to you as a church for the entry of the church into the rapture.

And I want right away to read from the Book of <u>Revelation chapter 6 verse 1 and 2</u> that you may understand the first seal; what happens when the first seal is broken? And what is the message to the church. Look at <u>Revelation chapter 6 verses 1 and 2</u>, He says, "¹ I watched as the Lamb opened the first of the seven seals. Then I heard one of the four living creatures say in a voice like thunder, "Come!" ² I looked, and there before me was a white horse! Its rider held a bow, and he was given a crown, and he rode out as a conqueror bent on conquest."

Again I repeat, He says, "¹ I watched as the Lamb opened the first of the seven seals. Then I heard one of the four living creatures say in a voice like thunder, "Come!" ² I looked, and there before me was a white horse! Its rider held a bow, and he was given a crown, and he rode out as a conqueror bent on conquest." That is the breaking of the first seal. But what is the importance of the breaking of that seal? What is the importance to the church? What is the message to the church when the first seal is broken? And I want to walk you very deep into the first seal that beginning today you may never say that you never knew.

Turn with me to Matthew 24. We are going to be trafficking between Matthew 24 and the Book of Revelation chapter 6. This is what He says in Matthew 24. I am beginning from verse 1 again. He says, "¹ Jesus left the temple and was walking away when his disciples came up to him to call his attention to its buildings. ² 'Do you see all these things?' he asked. 'I tell you the truth, not one stone here will be left on another; every one will be thrown down.' As Jesus was sitting on the Mount of Olives, his disciples came to him privately. "Tell us," they said, "when will this happen, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?"" And then verse 4 Jesus answers them, "Watch out that no one deceives you. ⁵ For many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many." And then down He gives

the rumors of war and wars; nation rising against nation; kingdom against kingdom; famines and earthquakes in various places.

But I want to handle <u>verse 4</u> and <u>verse 5</u> first. Listen precious people: if there is any important sign that the Lord left to the church, this is it. He warned against deception in the church. The first horse is the White Horse; the second, the Red Horse; the third, the Black Horse and the fourth, the Pale Horse. I want you to know that the White Horse, the rider of the White Horse, this rider is very different. He is so different from the rider of that horse you see in <u>Revelation chapter 19 verses 11 to verse 16</u>. And again we will read it right now so nobody says, he never heard. <u>Revelation chapter 19 verse 11</u>. The title says—<u>The Rider of the White Horse; verse 11</u> says, "¹¹ I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and wages war. ¹² His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no one knows but he himself. ¹³ He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God. ¹⁴ The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean."

And you remember the fine linen, bright and clean that the riders of the other horses with Him wear, this is the same fine linen, bright and clean that you see the church wearing before rapture in verses 6 to verse 9. In fact verse 8 he says, Revelation chapter 19, he says, "Fine line, bright and clean, was given her to wear." That means the righteousness and the holiness that the church prepares in rapture before this hour is eternal and that's why you see even when He is coming with the White Horse and the church is following Him to Jerusalem.

The church too, the raptured church is also wearing fine linen, bright and clean. But listen to verse 15, "...out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which he strikes down the nations." And He says, "He will rule them with an iron scepter." I was making the big difference between the rider of the White Horse that you see in Revelation chapter 6 verses 1 and 2 and the rider of the White Horse that you see in Revelation chapter 19 verses 11 to 16.

We know very well that the rider of the White Horse in the Book of <u>Revelation 19</u> <u>verses 11 to 16</u>, He is Christ. And that's why you see the raptured church is coming back together with Him in Jerusalem. But the rider of the White Horse that you see in <u>Revelation chapter 6 verses 1 and 2</u>, the rider of the White Horse that is one of the 4 apocalyptic horses that rider of the White Horse is different from the rider of the White Horse that comes to Jerusalem. And his name is Deception; he brings deception to the church; he brings spiritual deception to the church; if you want you can say he brings religious deception to the church. You see that he is coming with a bow. He is given a bow in his hand—the rider of the first among the four horses; the first horse which is the White Horse in <u>Revelation 6</u>. And yet we see Jesus on this other side comes with a sword.

Again the rider of the first horse when the first seal is broken, the White Horse, he is different from the Christ that comes to Jerusalem in Book of <u>Revelation chapter 19:11 to 16</u>. The rider of the White Horse that comes as a result of the breaking of the first seal, he is having a bow in his hand and yet Christ that comes in <u>Revelation chapter 19</u>, has a sword. Ok, the White Horse that comes when the first seal is broken brings horrendous suffering to the church, the most painful suffering that comes to the church among the 4 horses is the White Horse. And yet we see that Christ brings peace and joy to the church.

So I wanted you to get this difference very, very clearly and so you may know that among the 4 horses released by the breaking of the seal, it is the release of the first horse who is the White Horse that does the greatest damage to the church. I'm sure you are now asking yourself in surprise and shock, "How does that one make the greatest damage come to the church? How does he make the greatest damage come to the church when we know that when the Red Horse was announced, blood flowed and continues to flow across the earth?"—the war in Iraq, the war in Afghanistan, the war in Pakistan, the war in Somali, the war in DRC, the war, the war, the war, the war and blood, blood, blood across the earth; the war in Kenya that took place after elections; and many other wars all over the earth—the war in Sri Lanka; many, many wars and so that was due to the release of the Red Horse. A lot of blood flowed.

The Release of the Black Horse when I announced it and prophesied it in August 2008, it brought the most horrendous suffering across the earth. In fact that is one prophecy that I gave that literary affected every single person across the globe, the earth. So you must be asking yourself, "If the release of the Red Horse brings so much bloodshed all over the earth and the release of the Black Horse made many people lose their jobs, many companies crashed, famine and drought; then you must be asking then how come he is saying that the White one gave the greatest suffering?"

Listen very carefully because the White Horse that you see in <u>Revelation Chapter 6</u> that is released after the breaking of the first seal, he comes as a conqueror bent on conquest and he brings deception. You can see he wants to look like the other horse that Jesus will come with. (*Anajaribu sana kufanana na Yule ambaye ako kwenye* <u>Revelation chapter 19</u>) And that's why his name is Deception. And he has done the greatest damage to the church. And that's why Jesus was very articulate when He said, "Be careful that you are not deceived."

How did he bring the greatest suffering to the church? Because he brought religious and spiritual deception in the church; and why would that be the greatest damage to the church? Because he has brought into the church a deception that has literally pulled the Word away from the church; and to make it worse he arrives between the first coming of the Lord and now

this most anticipated second coming which means he comes at the most critical time when the church should be in right standing with God.

And what else does he do? He thrives on man. He comes at such a time when man's interest on religion has become very shallow. Number 2 he comes at such a time when men are now maintaining a very casual relationship and interest in God in the church. So he is able to thrive on them. You see he is able to thrive on the shallow interest on God, on the matters of God and he also thrives on the so called casual relationship and interest that man has with God in the church today; meaning not deep. And that means what he does essentially is to pull away the foundation of the church, the Bible, the Word.

What does that mean to the church today? That means when the White Horse was released; what did he do to the church? He brought a false Christianity to the church and that's why now a church that was purchased at a very high price—by the Blood of Jesus, the Blood of the Son of the Living God and separated from the world. Remember Jesus said, "I have overcome the world."

Remember the apostles: they hid themselves in the upper room until the Holy Ghost came to them. And they walked Christ and taught Christ, testified Christ, preached Christ, they talked Christ, they lived Christ, they ate Christ, and when they went to sleep, they dreamt Christ, when they woke up, they woke up Christ. They were Christ centered and yet when they died they also died for Christ. At that time the church was centered around the Word of God, Christ.

But now after such a high price that Jesus paid at Calvary now you see that when the White Horse was released and he brought spiritual deception into the church look at what happened: he removed the truth of the Word from the church. And now you find that the church which was supposed to have been separated; the Bible celebrates separation more than anything else.

In all Scripture he says, "Separate and come out from them." And now you find that when deception comes in, then the world entered the church; the world entered the church such that what you find in the world: let's say sexual sin, is exactly what you now find in the church; what you find in the world such as homosexuality, is exactly what you find in the church of Christ today. In fact they are now ordaining bishops and pastors who are homosexuals, openly gay in the church of Christ that was purchased at such a high price—that Jesus purchased that she may be called the elect which means separated from the rest; the special one. But now she is mixed with the world.

The love of money is in the world and now you find it right in the center of the church. And people are very shallow in their interest on God. If they had a deeper interest in God they would have dug in deeper and found the truth. They have a casual interest and relationship with the Lord. That is what the rider of the White Horse exploited. And so now all these world, the world that was supposed to be separated from the church has now entered the church because of the great deception that the White Horse has brought to the church.

We have talked about the other horses; the Red Horse and blood. I am going to talk much deeper when we come to that. We have talked about the Black Horse even as I prophesied it here—lack of jobs, people are suffering, they have no money, companies are collapsing, no jobs. But of all these things, you may be injured by a *panga* (masechette) cut; you may be injured by lacking a job, but still enter the Kingdom of God. But you cannot enter the Kingdom of God when you have been converted into this false Christianity that compromises with sin because the true benchmark and standard of the God for entry into the Kingdom of God is the holiness of the Lord in the church.

Again I repeat this. You can enter Heaven injured from the effects of the Red Horse, the bloodshed and the taking away of peace from man. But injured, maimed, crippled by the effects of the Red Horse but you can still enter the Kingdom of God if you are injured and you have maintained the true salvation of Christ. You may be injured by the effects of the Black Horse: let's say you lost your job and you have suffered so much looking for another job or you have lost your house because you cannot pay, but as long as you are walking right with Jesus you can still enter the Kingdom of God. But when the White Horse causes you to walk in a false Christianity, however healthy you are, however wealthy you are, you will go to eternal suffering in hell. And that is what the White Horse has done to the church.

That's why the effects of the White Horse are the most deadly and lethal to the church because they take the church right into eternal hell. Listen to what he says here, verse 6, " You will hear of wars and rumors of wars, but see to it that you are not alarmed. Such things must happen, but the end is still to come. Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be famines and earthquakes in various places. All these are the beginning of birth pains "Then you will be handed over to be persecuted and put to death, and you will be hated by all nations because of me." Verse 10 is very critical effect of the White Horse, " At that time many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other," and he says "...many false prophets will appear and deceive many people."

So he is saying in other words, Jesus was saying that He had seen the church in this dispensation before He comes and He had seen that the effects of the White Horse would cause many to turn away from true faith; that means apostasy of the church; to turn away from

the true faith of the Blood of Jesus, of the salvation of the Cross and now go to such a gospel like the gospel of prosperity.

And the effects of the White Horse are global. You can ask me, I am going across the nations literally every nation you get to, the gospel of prosperity has defiled the church such that the pastors are more interested now in the number of sheep. The more sheep the better because you will harvest more money and then you will be in prosperity. And yet when you rebuke sin, and preach holiness and righteousness and the Kingdom of God and repentance and the Blood and the Cross at Calvary, they are not interested. The sheep will walk away. You will end up with very few sheep. And so you will lose money; you will lose the offering and you will not prosper according to the definition of the world.

The gospel of prosperity was brought in by the White Horse. The effects of the White Horse into the church; the devastation by the White Horse on the church is the gospel of prosperity—he took away the true faith and then he replaced it with a false Christianity, a fallen Christianity; where now pastors can go in sexual sin with the members of the church; where now it is normal to see worship leaders fry their hair and men, the young boys put ear rings and nose rings. And so it is easier to see people dancing as if it is a disco and they call it worship in the church.

And now the White Horse came in this hour he created the concept of modern Christianity. That means, "It's ok, we can now live. We are modern. Miniskirts in the church;" they say "No, don't worry God only looks at the heart. The Lord does not care about how you dress" they say. They have brought a compromised kind of Christianity into the church and they have killed the church of Christ and the effect was global. That's why homosexuals now, ha, they are pastors in the church and yet the Bible speaks very, very clearly about homosexuality in Romans chapter 1 verse 21 onwards that God does not accept it in any way or form.

But how come we have now incorporated it whereby you hear most countries are now accepting homosexual pastors all over the world because of the effects of the White Horse that was released after the first seal was broken by the Lamb. And it was released because of the rebellious nature of the hearts of men. And that's why you see the Lamb is breaking the first seal and releasing it. And he brought the gospel of prosperity whereby now there is no preaching of holiness; whereby now the gospel Jesus gave us we have changed it; whereby now post modernism has entered inside into the church; whereby now the love of money has become the central part of church; whereby now pastors say that if you are not wealthy, if you are not doing well then that means you are not anointed—because of the effects of the White Horse that is released after the first seal is broken. He comes as a conqueror bent on conquest.

Surely he conquered the four ends of the earth. Any church you go to, even in India, you preach holiness and the Kingdom of God, the sheep just walk away. And you start preaching prosperity, how they are going to get a new job, a new car, a new home, with a big salary, your church will be full. The effects of the White Horse; apostasy; and it's a very big fall across the globe. Listen to me precious people, it is very severe.

The effects of the White Horse—worse than the effects of all the other horses combined; it is as though the Scripture that says, "Fear not he that can destroy your bodies, but fear he that can destroy your soul." It is as though that Scripture is fulfilled right here because the White Horse that is released after the breaking of the first seal, he comes directly to destroy the souls in the church and yet the only thing Jesus died for on the cross is the souls of the saints. You see how he is Deception because he is also fighting for souls and yet the Lord fought for souls.

Listen to me precious people at this time when you look at the church of Christ in this last hour how she cannot even hear the voice of the Holy Spirit; that means she is far from been salvaged. She cannot even be redeemed. When you look at the church of Christ world over today you see that it is as though the death of Jesus on the cross, the crucifixion of Jesus on the cross and His resurrection was not enough for the church as if she needs a second deliverance. That is how devastating the effects of the White Horse that is released after the breaking of the first seal, that is how devastating the effects are; the other horses can destroy the body. They seem the body. But this one destroys the soul. He brings deception into the church.

The Bible cannot contradict itself. And that's why you see that when Paul received revelation on these days before the coming of the Messiah, he saw the same thing. The Book of 2 Timothy chapter 3 verse 1 all the way to verse 5, he says "1 But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days." Paul calls it "terrible times" which means the worst times ever. Verse 2, "2 People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, 3 without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good, 4 treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God—5 having a form of godliness but denying its power." And the instruction of the Holy Spirit was this, "You have nothing to do with them. Don't ever have anything to do with them."

And you see Jesus was warning here too that there will be apostasy—the falling away from true faith in Christ Jesus. That is the effect of the White Horse that is released after the first seal is broken that they may fall away from the true faith in Christ Jesus and now have a form of godliness and yet lacking in its power. We know that the power of godliness, the power of God is the Holy Spirit. And yet we know that the Holy Spirit, He is holy. And that's why

today's church cannot even embrace the Holy Spirit because if they are looking for revival the type of revival we see in Kenya today can only be driven by the Holy Spirit. And when He comes then that revival has to be a holy revival.

You come to church today and you hear them talking about revival, "and you see we brought 2 preachers. We have revival this weekend in our church. That man, he can preach. We really had a very good revival in the church." Even their understanding of revival is perverted; has been destroyed by the White Horse because he found them very shallow and casual with God; so that they call revival. And we know that when the Holy Ghost brings revival to the church it will last if the church walks in holiness.

Only holiness can ignite revival and sustain revival in the church. Precious people do you now understand when I say that the effects of the White Horse are far more devastating than all the other 3 combined on the church of Christ. I am going to move to the next level; I am going to move to the most critical next level. For example you hear what Jesus said here, verse 12, He said "12 Because of the increase of wickedness," Matthew 24 verse 12, "12 Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold." What did the Lord Jesus mean there in that prophecy? He meant that Christians would become lukewarm and when the Bible, the Holy Spirit, the love, the love of many, what does He mean by love in the Bible?

He means Agape love; the love of God on man and yet we all know that the love of God directed to men we know that that is Jesus. And so when He says the love of many will grow cold; in some other versions of the Bible He says, "The Love of many will wax cold." (Kama musumaa ambao ulikua unachoma alafu ikakua baridi. Sasa imekauka kwa meza. Imekauka kwa meza) And that means that the love for Christ will disappear from the church because if surely the church loves Christ she will remember the cross and the Blood at Calvary and nothing else can ever steal her heart from Jesus.

I am going to expound deeper now on the other side of the short worship break that you may even see how the White Horse came and split the remnant church. But we see very clearly here that the effects of the White Horse are far more devastating because of the post-modernism he brought into the church. Now the modern Christians miniskirts, tight trousers, slits, they are normal; *tumbo* cuts, open breasts, they are normal it has become normal in the church today because, "Look we are a modern church." He brought the gospel of prosperity that mostly focuses on the earth; O...O Lord, on the earth! Wealth, wealth and health—how you can be wealthy on the earth and live healthy on the earth.

If you want to see the true effects of the White Horse watch the Christian Television today. What will you find? You will find that Christians, churches, pastors, they are busy selling things on TV that "If you buy this today, this is the offer for today, you will get gratis, the bonus

this one here." If you look at the church today, even the dressing of women, even the gospel of prosperity—the gospel of "Sow a seed, buy your miracle here." Then you will fear for the church. The church is focusing on how to live well on the earth because of the great deception that the White Horse has brought. And yet at this last hour, the church ought to have been focusing on the Kingdom of God.

I am going to take you to the next level that you may see even the greatest devastation that has happened as result of the White Horse. For example the way he has even split the remnant church. But we will go into a short break and that's why I told you that today it's very, very deep. The revelation you get from here, you can literally run with it into the Kingdom of God. When you miss this, I don't want to say, but you will be in very, very bad place.
